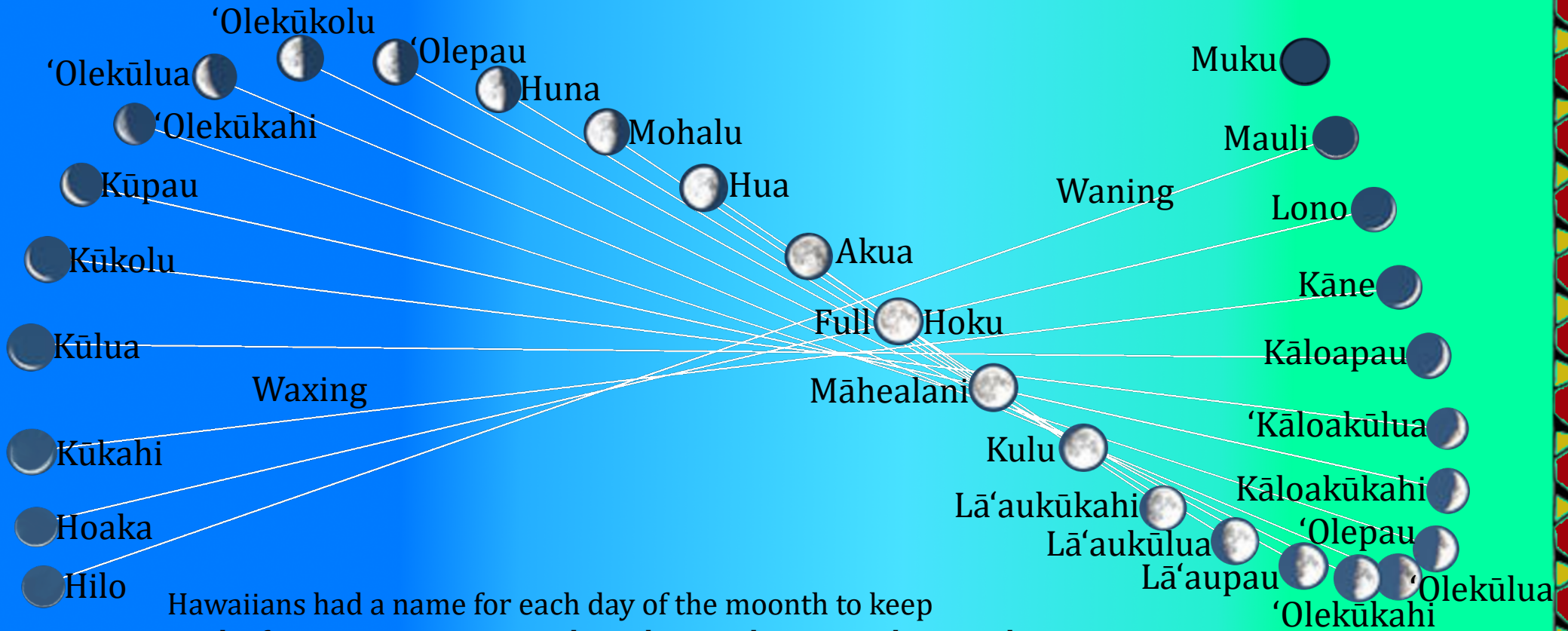


# The Lunar Wave

## Hawaiian Surfers 30-Day Moonth Calendar



Hawaiians had a name for each day of the moonth to keep track of time, navigation at night, to know when it was best to plant, harvest, fish, and surf. A direct reflection of sunlight, the brightly lit moon is eclipsed by Earth in a perpetual point/counter point figure  $\infty$  Sine wave. Interwoven electromagnetic gravitational forces flowing between the Sun, Earth, and Moon manipulates ocean tides, plant growth, and animal and human behavior. The dynamic Sun - Earth - Moon cresting wave/deep swell cycle surfing from new moon to full moon is called the waxing phase. Conversely the balancing act phenomena of the moon surfing from full moon to new moon is called the waning phase.
